St. Margaret's Annual Keelboat Regatta  
August 11th - 12th, 2018

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

**RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The rules of PHRF-NS will apply to handicap fleets.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The regatta is open to boats with a current PHRF-NS Yacht Data Sheet for handicap racing. The Race Committee may extend eligibility to boats without a PHRF-NS Yacht Data Sheet by assigning a provisional rating for use in this regatta only. The person in charge (ordinarily, but not necessarily the entrant) shall meet the requirements of Rule 46 and the Sail Canada prescription thereto.

**CLASSES:** A and B handicap classes racing on a time-on-time basis, with fleet split to be determined after close of registration. C handicap class ('Cruiser') racing on a time-on-time basis without spinnakers, with fore-and-aft sails only (e.g., Jib and main for sloops).

**REGISTRATION:** Registration is \$75 plus HST. First time SMAKR competitors receive 10% off their registration fee. Registration is available online beginning August 1 and at SMSC as per the following schedule.

**INSURANCE:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
