Emergency Operations:

Please report any accidents or injuries, however minor, to the SMSC Safety Coordinator so that appropriate action can be taken. The Volunteer Coordinator, Sarah Kirby, at the volunteer desk, is the duty Safety Coordinator. For minor injuries a first aid kit may be found outside of the Manager’s office on the main level of the clubhouse.

For land-based emergencies: In the event of any serious emergency Dial 911 on your phone
